Citizenship	Student must keep all citizenship reports to at least S	Required
Bible Reading	Student to read New Testament (any non-paraphrased version)	Required
School Service	Student to dedicate themselves to a project that serves the school: cleaning, flower beds, etc	1 merit per hour max 10
Community Service	Charity work: Calvary Food Ministry, Samaritan's Purse or Empty Stocking, etc	1 merit per hour max 10
Tutoring	Student with teacher approval works to encourage and improve fellow students academic abilities.	3 merits per student max 9
Band	Student earns outstanding improvement award.	3 merits
Art	Student earns Art project award	1 merits for project entry 3 merits for award 1 merit for external display 3 merits for hanging team max 10

Sports	Each Coach can give one award per event for sportsmanship.	1 merit per event max 5
Ag	Student earns Ag project award	3 merits
Reading	Student to read from list of advanced books and present thorough report in Literature class.	3 merits per book max 12
Speech	Student to present approved topic to school in Chapel	1 merit per presentation max 3
Music Performance	Performing music in public outside of Band	1 merit per performance max 5
Writing Project	Student completes a play, short story, essay, news story or the result of an interview	3 merit per project max 12
Old Testament Reading	Student reads book of the old testament (any non-paraphrased version)	3 merits per book maximum 12
Bible Memorization	Student to memorize approved passages of 10 verses from KJV and recite	1 merit per successful recital max 10
Academic Improvement	Student sets a goal to make a marked skill improvement such as penmanship, memorize math tables, correct language habit, etc	1 merit per successful demonstration max 10
